Antique front door is etched & beveled glass and came out of a pub & bakery in England.

The barricade protection door is reclaimed lumber and a solid piece from larger trees harvested many decades ago.

Swedish Cope logs are from Canada (not available anymore), and they are hand crafted by log wood crafting artist Ron Kalavig from Bridger, Montana. He also hand crafted the stairway and railings.

Primitive door installed as a wall in kitchen is 400-450 years old and came from a mission in Zacatagus, Mexico. It is mesquite and has blacksmith hand beaten hardware.

Pantry door is pine and very old from Mexico

Master bathroom chandelier is from the hotel where the movie *Giant* was filmed (1920's art deco).

Stair case spindle railings near pantry are from the old monastery at Red Lodge, Montana. Seller will leave 3" oak staircase railing to be installed as foot rest for bar stools. (also from the monastery)

Slate kitchen counter top from Crazy Mountain Cabinetry in Livingston.

Bathroom sinks are hand painted. Sale also includes antique etched and beveled mirrors in the bathrooms.

Fireplace is Chief Joseph Slate, harvested where the Indian chief used to roam.

Simulated wood stove is propane, 28,000 BTU radiant heat in floor.

Five Star cook stove is commercial scale adapted for residential use. White porcelain with brass handles. 6 burners, griddle, double oven and broilers with convection – fantastic for making perfect pies and breads.

Halogen ceiling lights enhance logs and art work.

Will include Amish made four poster bed in master bedroom if interested. Will include choice of bar stools: 4 swivel stools from the old Cripple Creek Saloon in Colorado, or padded stools also old from Montana.
