A golfer's dream . . . three of the state's top ten courses are in Cumberland County with 11 courses and 216 holes!

That said, let's move on to Fairfield Glade and the golfing there! This has to be at the top of the list of all the attractions that bring people here. Fairfield Glade is home to five championship golf courses with a combined total of 90 holes that will challenge every golfer. Each course offers 18 holes with one exception that offers an amazing 36 holes!! The most renowned course is Stonehenge, (the only public course) the number one rated new resort in the United States by *Golf Digest* magazine when it first opened and it has consistently ranked as one of the top 20 every year since. The Tennessee Open immediately became a seasonal event at this fine course.

Realizing that all Fairfield's courses are in the same geographical location, they vary remarkably in beauty and challenging play. If mountain vistas appeal to you, Druid Hills is the choice. By the same token, if you desire relatively flat land, try Heatherhurst. If you're hitting short but straight and like contrasting nines, Dorchester will provide. Need something even more challenging than usual, the blue tees at Stonehenge are there for those with

These courts are watered by the Lee Hydro Court System of underground watering, which keeps the courts in perfect playing condition around the clock. Now for the other 4 hard surfaced outdoor courts – at about half the price and more suited to everyday players – two are located at Druid Hills and two at Dorchester Country Clubs here at Fairfield Glade.
