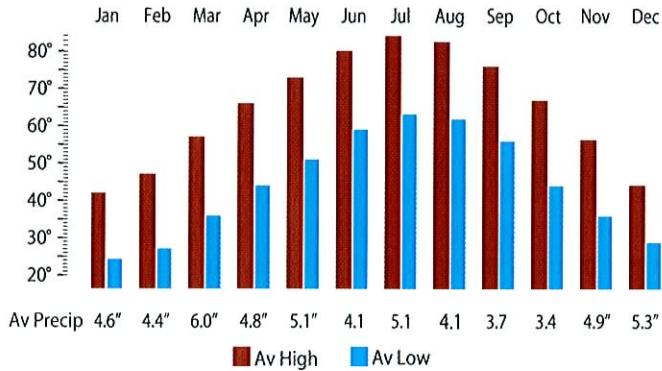


Weather & Lakes



One of the most enjoyable features of our area is the moderate year round temperatures. Mild summer days and cool summer nights are attributable to the Plateau's elevation which also allows for much lower humidity factors than most of the south. Even during the hottest months, the relative humidity reaches only about 72 percent. We do get snow in winter months; however, it is usually no more than an overnight dusting that fades quickly, at most a couple of days. The following is a sample of the average yearly temps and precipitation for the area.

Now, that may look like a lot of precipitation, but out of 56", almost 11" is snow. Yet this is what allows for the lush, green trees, grass, and foliage naturally. . . and being spread throughout the year it never feels like a rainy or dry spell.

Now, speaking of weather, most residents here put these great days and nights to use by taking advantage of the 11 lakes located throughout Fairfield Glade by boating or fishing. Because the many lakes are man-made and spring-fed, they are free of pollution and boast crystal clear waters. They are also stocked with large and small mouth bass, yellow perch, bream, shell crackers, crappie, channel catfish, and blue catfish. The depths and high oxygen content offered by the springs on Lake Dartmoor, Kirkstone and Glastowbury are also home to rainbow trout and walleye.
