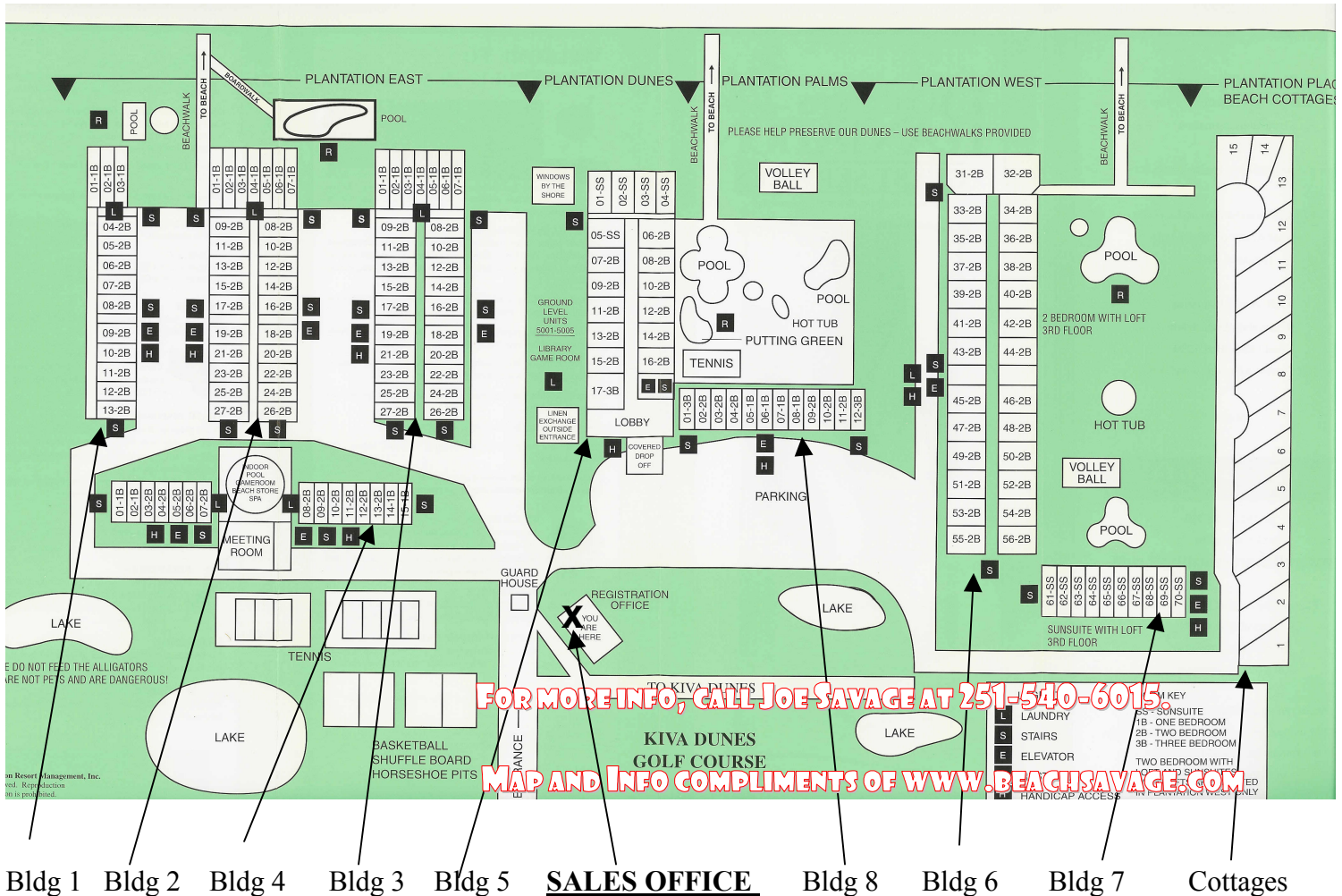


FINDING A UNIT AT THE GULF SHORES PLANTATION RESORT

In the map above...

- "Plantation East" refers to the original GULF SHORES PLANTATION. It contains buildings 1 through 4.
- "Plantation Dunes" refers to ROYAL GULF BEACH AND RACQUET CLUB. It is building 5 (the "highrise")
- "Plantation Palms" refers to PLANTATION PALMS. It is building 8.
- "Plantation West" refers to RESORT CONFERENCE CENTER. It contains buildings 6 and 7.

In the map above, the numbers and letters on each "stack" represent the number of the stack in the building, as well as what the configuration of that stack is (2B=2 Bedroom; 1B=1 Bedroom; 3B=3 Bedroom, SS=Sunsuite Efficiency.)

The number of a unit contains the following:

First Digit=The building it is in. The exceptions to this are buildings 6, 7, and 8. The first digit for units in Buildings 6-7 is always one, but the last two digits are all greater than 30. In Building 8 (Palms), the first digit is 6.

Second Digit= The Floor the unit is on...1=first floor; 2=second floor, and so on.

Third and fourth digit= The "Stack" the unit is in. That is, units that end in -03 would all be in the "03 stack" of the building, just on different floors. So, 2103, 2203, and 2303 would all be in Building 2, be on the first, second and third floors, respectively and all be in the -03 stack.
