The Resort and Golf Course

There is so much happening at Omni Mount Washington Resort - with a history beginning in the 1700s, in the shadow of the Northeast's highest peaks, you can imagine the possibilities. A place as unique for its magnificent natural setting as it is for its glorious history and architecture, Omni Mount Washington Resort is simply unforgettable. Home to the Omni Mount Washington Hotel, fabled for its elegance and grandeur, and the Mount Washington Course, a Donald Ross original golf course that was unveiled this past summer, according to its original design of 1915 and has been lovingly restored based on the specifications of the original plans by renowned architect Brian Silva.

The Omni Mount Washington Hotel, which played host to the Bretton Woods International Conference in 1944, is and always will be the stunning centerpiece of Omni Mount Washington Resort; and with recent renovations and restoration, New Hampshire's historic Grande Dame has never been more beautiful. With the January 2009 unveiling of the new Presidential Wing, the first construction at the Hotel in over 100 years, along with the additional refurbishments inside and out, she has been revitalized, becoming a four-season destination without parallel in New England.

The Presidential Wing houses the new Spa, very much inspired by its natural surroundings, and an additional 20,000 square feet of meeting and event space. And it is topped by the Jewell Terrace, a landscaped rooftop garden that makes you want to reach out and touch Mount Washington!

The Hotel and Renovations

The Omni Mount Washington Hotel, the historic all-season property located at the base of 6,288-foot Mt. Washington, has recently completed an extensive renovation which includes an array of additions and enhancements including the addition of a new wing, the Presidential Wing, which houses a new spa and meeting space facility. Recent changes include a \$2 million restoration to the Hotel's 900-foot wrap-around Veranda, Great Hall and Dining Room. The Activities Desk was added as a new customer service feature in the refurbished Great Hall. Fresh designs, new furniture and noteworthy decorations adorn the Hotel's Great Hall and pre-function areas which highlight the importance of the Resort's natural setting. The Resort's deep history is honored throughout as elements of the past are woven into the many new design details.

The enhancements are first evident when guests arrive at The Omni Mount Washington Hotel and are greeted by the Hotel's 900-foot Veranda which has been recently painted and adorned with new furniture. Upon entering the Great Hall, guests are surrounded by the nature just outside the resort as well as its historic past. New furniture is in evidence throughout the Great Hall, all of which was carefully selected to provide the cozy feel of a personal living room.
